### Secretary of State



Travis-Austin: Bey (born August 1<sup>st</sup> 1984) is a National Government Official, Humanitarian, and Father who, since April 14<sup>th</sup> 2020, has been serving as United States of America Republic Secretary of State. He is the former U.S.A.R. Commerce Commissioner and was the Governor for the Province of Missouri from 2018-2019.

Austin: Bey, appointed by the President C-Cannon: Bey with the advice and consent of the Senate, is the President's chief foreign affairs adviser. As Secretary, carries out the President's foreign policies through the State Department and the Foreign Service of the United States of America Republic;

- Serves as the President's principal adviser on U.S.A.R. foreign policy;
- Conducts negotiations relating to U.S.A.R. foreign affairs;
- Grants and issues passports to Moorish American Citizens and exequaturs to foreign consuls in the United States of America Republic;
- Advises the President on the appointment of U.S.A.R. ambassadors, ministers, consuls, and other diplomatic representatives;
- Advises the President regarding the acceptance, recall, and dismissal of the representatives of foreign governments;
- Personally participates in or directs U.S.A.R. representatives to international conferences, organizations, and agencies;
- Negotiates, interprets, and terminates treaties and agreements;
- Ensures the protection of the U.S.A.R. National Government to Moorish American citizens, property, and interests in foreign countries;
- Supervises the administration of U.S.A.R. immigration laws abroad;
- Provides information to Moorish American Citizens regarding the political, economic, social, cultural, and humanitarian conditions in foreign countries;
- Informs the Congress and Moorish American Citizens on the conduct of U.S.A.R. foreign relations;
- Promotes beneficial economic intercourse between the United States of America Republic and other countries;
- Administers the Department of State;
- Supervises the Foreign Service of the United States of America Republic.
- In addition, the Secretary of State retains domestic responsibilities that Congress entrusted to the State Department in 2015. These include the custody of the Great Seal of the United States of America Republic, the preparation of certain presidential proclamations, the publication of treaties and international acts as well as the official record of the foreign relations of the United States of America Republic, and the custody of certain original treaties and international agreements. The Secretary also serves as the channel of communication between the National Government and the States on the extradition of fugitives to or from foreign countries.
